Liven up your space with rich, punchy shades that invigorate and are oh-so-pretty to look at



FUN & EASY WAYS TO ADD COLOR

Don't go overboard. Pick one wall or one piece (even a door!) and get acquainted



WALLPAPER ONE WALL Enhance a room's color scheme by playing up one shade and featuring it on wallpaper. Look for designs that have patterns—like vertical or horizontal stripes—to add depth, says color expert David Oliver of the Paint & Paper Library. Simple patterns also make it easy to create seamless looks if you are doing the job yourself. Sunlight may fade paper's ink, so avoid walls that receive direct rays.
