


An Interview with David Bromstad

4 If you had to choose one interior designer to have free reign over designing your home, without your help or input beyond an initial consultation, who would you select and why?


Oh honey, without a doubt in the world...Philippe Starck, hands down! I would sit back with a cocktail and let him go to work! He is absolutely my FAVE!






S Is there a design trend that's made a comeback that you're really excited about?
